

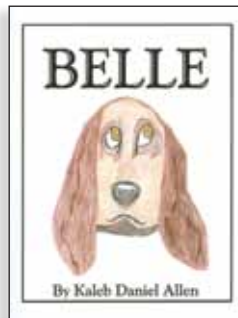
Congratulations to Our Student Authors!

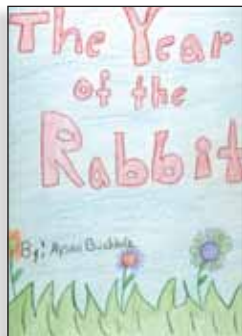
the Wisconsin State Reading Association for judging this year's entries. Thank you as well to all districts who have participated in this contest, which is in its 18th and final year.
