

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT - Webster School District

Job Description: The Webster School District consists of an Elementary School which includes Early Childhood, 4-Year-Old Kindergarten, and 5-Year-Old Kindergarten through grade 4, and also a Middle/High School servicing grades 5-12. The district student enrollment is 672 and is staffed by 107 employees. The district covers roughly 550 square miles and is the second largest district in the State of Wisconsin in terms of geographical area. On average, 660 students are transported to and from school on one of 13 bus routes. The buses travel about 995 miles per day which is slightly less than 180,000 miles per school year. The school library has a collection of over 20,000 books for students to utilize every day. Along with the changes in education through time, the district has adopted a 1:1 Chromebook Initiative with students in Grades 2-12, allowing them to stay current in the digital technology age.

The Village of Webster is located in Burnett County and is known as the Sunfish Capital of Wisconsin. Outstanding recreation activities abound year-round with fishing, hunting snowmobiling, and skiing among some of the many activities available.
