The Raymond School District #14 is located in Racine County in southeast Wisconsin. It is 18 miles from Milwaukee, 12 miles from Racine, 9 miles from Oak Creek and 7 miles from Franklin. It serves the Franksville and Caledonia communities in one building, 4k-grade 8.

According to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction district report card for 2022-23, the Raymond School District #14 exceeds expectations. Almost one-third of its students open enrolled into the district school.
