# **About the School District**

The Durand-Arkansaw School District has two school buildings. Caddie Woodlawn Elementary School houses 488 students in PreK-5th grade, and the Durand-Arkansaw Middle & High School has 531 students in grades 6-12. We have had a slight increase in enrollment over the past couple years and enrollment is currently holding steady. The district outsources our maintenance/custodial services and our bus transportation. The district also contracts with the City of Durand for a school resource officer.

The electors of the school district passed a referendum in April 2015 for remodeling and additions to both Caddie Woodlawn Elementary School and the Durand-Arkansaw Middle & High School. The projects were completed in 2016. A new football field and track was completed in 2018 with a synthetic turf and a rubberized running track. New softball fields and a concession stand were completed in 2022 at Tarrant Park in Durand.

# District Highlights

• A Senior Awards & Scholarship Program is held every May. Last May, the program awarded more than \$625,000 in scholarships to our graduating seniors.

 The district offers some Advanced Placement courses and some transcripted courses through Chippewa Valley Technical College.

- Extracurricular opportunities include Academic Decathlon, Forensics, Drama, Student Council, Esports, FFA, Skills USA, Pep Club and Yearbook.
- Athletic programs include football, volleyball, boys' and girls' cross country, wrestling, boys' and girls' basketball, golf, baseball, softball, and girls' and boys' track.

• The district has a school resource officer.







The Durand-Arkansaw School District is located in the scenic hills and valleys along the southern end of the Chippewa River in Durand, Wisconsin. The school district serves the communities of Durand, Arkansaw, Eau Galle, Nelson and Rock Falls. It is approximately 20 miles from Menomonie and 30 miles from Eau Claire. The school district covers approximately 250 square miles and is composed of 16 municipalities in the counties of Pepin, Buffalo and Dunn.

Summer festivals include the Durand Fun Fest and Arkansaw Creek Park Day. Music events include Music in the Park in Durand three times during the summer and Blues on the Chippewa, a weekend event in Durand during August. The community uses the Chippewa River State Trail for biking and hiking; it extends from Durand to Eau Claire and junctions with the Red Cedar State Trail. The community also has a golf course, and a new swimming pool is being constructed and will open in 2025.
