Dux Appointed to WASB Board of Directors

Larry Dux, a long-time member of the Pewaukee School Board, was recently appointed to the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin Association of School Boards. His appointment, effective immediately, was confirmed during the board's Nov. 8 meeting in Stevens Point.

"Wisconsin is recognized as a leader in K-12 education, and the WASB strives to maintain that leadership position by supporting, promoting and advancing the interests of public education," says Dux, who has first elected to the Pewaukee School Board in 2002. "I believe I can contribute to the work of the WASB."

Dux will represent WASB Region 15, which includes more than 30 school districts in eastern Wisconsin. As the director, he will advocate for school districts in his region and across the state.

"We're delighted to welcome Larry to our board," WASB Executive Director Dan Rossmiller says. "His extensive experience and deep commitment to public education make him a valuable addition to our team. He has the knowledge and passion to make an immediate impact."

Dux assumes the role previously held by Cherie Rhodes, who resigned in August 2024. He will serve in an interim role until the Region 15 Fall Regional Meeting in 2025, when an election will be held for a full three-year term beginning in January 2026.

"A strong public education system is essential to ensuring that Wisconsin employers can hire workers with the knowledge and skills necessary for long-term success," says Dux, who attended public schools in Neillsville, Wis., before earning a bachelor's degree in industrial engineering and a master's in business administration from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. "My education allowed me to have a successful career in healthcare information systems."
